- DO NOT SHARE YOUR NAME, ADDRESS, PHONE NUMBER OR PASSWORD TO STRANGERS ONLINE.
- DELETE RISQUE OR SUGGESTIVE MESSAGES OR DO NOT RESPOND.
- ALWAYS HAVE PARENTAL SUPERVISION WHEN MEETING SOMEONE OFFLINE.
- TELL A PARENT OR TEACHER IF YOU ARE IN DANGER OR KNOW OF SOMEONE WHO IS IN TROUBLE.
- THINK BEFORE YOU POST INFORMATION SO THAT IT DOES NOT LEAD TO EMBARRASSMENT OR EXPOSURE TO DANGER IN THE FUTURE.
- DO NOT OPEN ANY EMAILS OR DOWNLOAD ATTACHMENTS FROM UNFAMILIAR SOURCES.
