If you do not receive your grade report in the mail, or if you need to have an extra copy or official transcript, you may use one of the methods listed below to request what you need. Your student ID number is your social security number, and your initial PIN number is your birthdate in the MMDDYY format (6 digits). You will be required to change your initial PIN to another number the first time you use this system. DO NOT FORGET your PIN as you will need it for all future requests!
